Duo Sonore

Duo Sonore is a two-drums band, source of melodies and harmonies. Our music is direct and percussive. We move between trance, improvisations, powerful rhythms, lulls and sound experiments. The duo offers a wide spectrum of sounds. The set contains only originals compositions that can remind Pierre Favre or more current references such as electronic music and experimental scene. Driven by the desire to explore borders and create musical encounters, the duo proposes when it is possible, an improvised set with a guest musician such as Ganesh Geymeier or Marc Méan.

Yann Hunziker and Clément Grin are both drummers/percussionists from the Haute Ecole de Jazz de Lausanne. In the spring of 2019, they publish sound experimentation videos on the Instagram account @duo_sonore_. In September 2019, the duo performs at the Bourg in Lausanne for a unique creation accompanied by the Swiss saxophonist Ganesh Geymeier during a 2nd set totally improvised. A 1st EP is released in February 2020. In June 2020, the duo will record their 1st album at the Studio de la Fonderie in Fribourg.

Clément Grin

In 2nd year master interpretation in the class of Emil Spanyi and Norbert Pfammatter at the Haute Ecole de Jazz de Lausanne, Clément Grin is a jazz drummer and composer. He is a founding member of Montagne! Trio, Monument, Duo Sonore, Clément Grin Quintet and the Collectif du Présent. Fascinated by poetry, multidisciplinary creations and improvisation, he continues his path through new musical encounters. He has notably performed at the Cully Jazz Festival and Jazz Onze+.

Active on the Swiss scene for several years now, he has given a large series of concerts with Montagne! Trio (Cully Jazz, Verbier Classique, Nova Jazz), Monument (Les Docks, La Bâtie, Le Bourg, Rock Altitude, le Romandie, Werk 21). Montagne! Trio organized a church tour in May and June 2019 with Aurélie Emery. They played with musicians such as Bänz Oester (Old Europe), Nicolas Masson Quartet, Emil Spanyi, Louis Matute, Aurélie Emery and Ganesh Geymeier. Winner of the Talent and Creativity Grant of the Barrière Foundation 2019.

Yann Hunziker

Passionate about sound and an outstanding improviser of rhythms and sound universes of all kinds, Yann is a musician on the move. He's interested in singing and playing the piano, but his main instrument remains the drums, which he trained on at the Haute Ecole de Musique de Lausanne (HEMU) where he obtained his master's degree in jazz interpretation. Active in Zahnfleisch, Rekhabelsah and Duo Sonore, he is currently pursuing his training at the Lausanne Conservatory in classical singing (countertenor).

Sensitive to the meeting points between the different arts, he regularly collaborates with other artists, musicians and choreographers such as Pascal Auberson, David Zambrano, Matthieu Michel, Ganesh Geymeier or Susanne Abbuehl.
